Write a critique of **Fish Face** OR draw a picture of Emily and Dawn.

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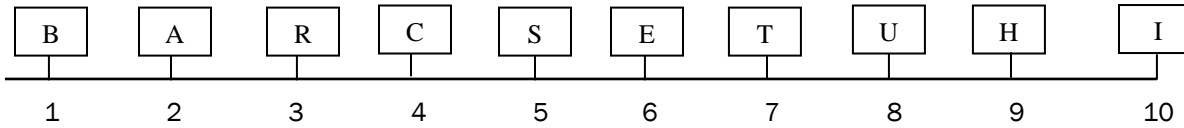
